Now that you have completed your Basic Open Water Diver program and possibly the advanced diver program it's time for the next step. Pre-requisites:

1. 1. Advanced Open Water Diver or equivalent with documented experience in Deep and U/W Navigation
2. 2. 20 Logged Dives
3. 3. Minimum age 15 (12) for Junior Rescue Diver
4. 4. Entry Level Open Water divers may complete the Academic and Pool portion of rescue course
5. 5. Must be current in CPR/First Aid prior to beginning of course
