The Open Top Snorkel has been around for a long time. The first versions were simply a tube, open at the top and a mouthpiece at the bottom. The newer version is open at the top, and on the other end is the mouthpiece along with a purge valve that will allow some water to automatically drain out. An open top snorkel will allow water to enter on the surface by wave action or dipping the snorkel under water.

The Semi Dry Snorkel is an improvement over the open top as it has a piece on the top that will baffle out some of the water that may try to enter the snorkel on the surface. Like the open top however it will fully flood if dipped under water. The semi dry incorporates the same style purge valve as the open top.
